Our flooring may be stored for a very short period before installation provided that it is stored in an environment where the humidity levels are very close to the actual living conditions that will be maintained in the home. Avoid storage in a garage, uncontrolled warehouse, trailer, new home without heat, or any other location where there might be high or variable humidity conditions. The material will absorb moisture if exposed to these conditions, causing possible warping, bowing, and/or cupping.
